The Student Government Association (SGA) welcomes your decision to apply for a student representative position on the Student Activity Fee Advisory Committee. Below are the requirements to serve on this committee and the steps to complete the application process.

Requirements: The SGA Executive Committee appoints student representatives to the Student Activity Fee Advisory Committee (SAFAC). Students interested in applying for a SAFAC position must maintain good academic standing (at least a cumulative GPA of 2.0), enrollment in a **minimum of six (6) credit hours** (per semester in Fall and Spring) at CCCCD, **and at least one (1) credit hours** at the campus which you are appointed to (this does not apply to the At-Large position). Your availability during summer semesters will be required. Alternate representatives will also be appointed from applications.

Instructions: Please provide the information below and attach an essay of 250 words or less to this application. The essay should state why the candidate desires to serve on this committee. Completed applications should be returned in a sealed envelope to Student Life Office and submitted to Lynda Gates, Director of Student Life **as soon as possible** (CPC D109, PRC A184, or SCC F129).
